Known Issues

1. Trouble uploading charts with when unit staffing is filled out

Workaround: In the event and error occurs please remove the unit staffing and reattempt upload

2. Crew level certification missing from chart after upload

Workaround: Manually select crew level certification on emsCharts Web

3. Custom Vital Signs labels appear incorrectly on web

Workaround: None

4. Patient race missing from chart after upload

Workaround: Manually selecting race on emsCharts Web

5. Factors affecting care are missing from chart after upload if all factors are set to NONE

Workaround: Manually selecting factors on emsCharts Web

6. County drop down field data is missing when search by zip code is done

Workaround: Navigating to a different page and then returning to patient information, upon reselecting field data is now available, you can manually select the County
